

East Lake PTA General Meeting

September 26, 2017

Co –Presidents Jen Azzariti and Judy Snyder opened the meeting at 7:15.

A quorum was present.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Introduction of the new PTA board members took place.

The Treasurer's report – Start of the year balance: \$26,282.17 Now: \$23,213.67. Money was used for the fall fundraiser Boosterthon investment, Class parent tea, Boo Hoo Yahoo Breakfast, and assignment planners.

The Membership report was given: 314 people signed up. 34 staff members, 222 single memberships, 112 family memberships. 10 more online signed up that day.

2017-2018 Budget Vote was held. Money was added to the Kindergarten budget line from \$500 to \$600. The budget was approved.

The NY Blood Service guest speaker could not attend. Instead Jen Azzariti spoke about signing up to donate blood on 11/2 from 2:45-8:45. We have a target of 70 donations. Class moms were asked to send out emails to their class asking them to please sign up and donate blood.

2017 Fundraiser Boosterthon was discussed. Questions were answered about what Boosterthon is and how it worked to raised money for the school.

Picture Day on 10/2 was discussed. The new way of ordering pictures was explained.

Committee reports were given from Family Fun, Outreach, East Lake Essentials, Kindergarten, Arts in Education, Box Tops, Reflections, etc. Some committees needed more members.
